Dear Tom Joyal Builder,

The Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) recently reviewed the Certificate of Title Application for your ZAP vehicle. During the review, the Bureau learned the ZAP has a steering wheel and not handlebars. Because the ZAP is new to us and does not have steering similar to a typical motorcycle, the BMV consulted the Maine State Police regarding vehicle definition and inspection. The consultation revealed that, even though the Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) labels the ZAP a motorcycle, it will not pass a motorcycle inspection because it has a steering wheel.

In light of the information pertaining to vehicle inspection, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles asks you to send in the motorcycle plate and registration issued to you on May 23, 2008. You should send them to the address listed below, attention Registration Section. Your registration will then be listed as inactive.

Failure to comply with the request of this letter, within 10 business days, will result in suspension of the plate (MC) 157 EP and registration certificate.

Your title application will be withdrawn and returned to you. The Bureau's Accounting Section will return your \$23.00 application fee.
